### **Responsibility for Students**

Whilst at the centre, the responsibility for student behaviour lies with the classroom teacher/carers.

The Barwon Waste Wise Education Centre reserves the right to ask the classroom teacher to remove any student/s whose behaviour is deliberately and consistently disruptive, to the foyer.

### **Code of Conduct**

It is requested that teachers read the following Code of Conduct and monitor student behaviour on the day to ensure a rewarding and enjoyable experience.

### **Students are required to:**

- Behave in a courteous and responsible manner at all times.
- Refrain from swinging on the balustrade as they enter/exit the building.
- Keep their pace to a walk inside the centre
- Use the handrails when going up and down the stairs to the first storey
- Respect the displays and not deliberately attempt to damage them
- Always have teacher/parent/carer supervision when leaving the group (e.g. going to the toilet)

### **Student Teacher Ratio**

Please note that the Barwon Waste Wise Education Centre can accommodate 2 groups per session, with a maximum of 25 students in each group. The Centre has a policy requirement of a minimum of 2 adults per group, one of which must be a teacher. (e.g. 40 students would be separated into 2 groups of 20 and each group requires a teacher and adult).

If in any circumstances DEECD or CEO guidelines require a higher number of supervising adults than the Centre, then the DEECD or CEO policies should be adhered to.
